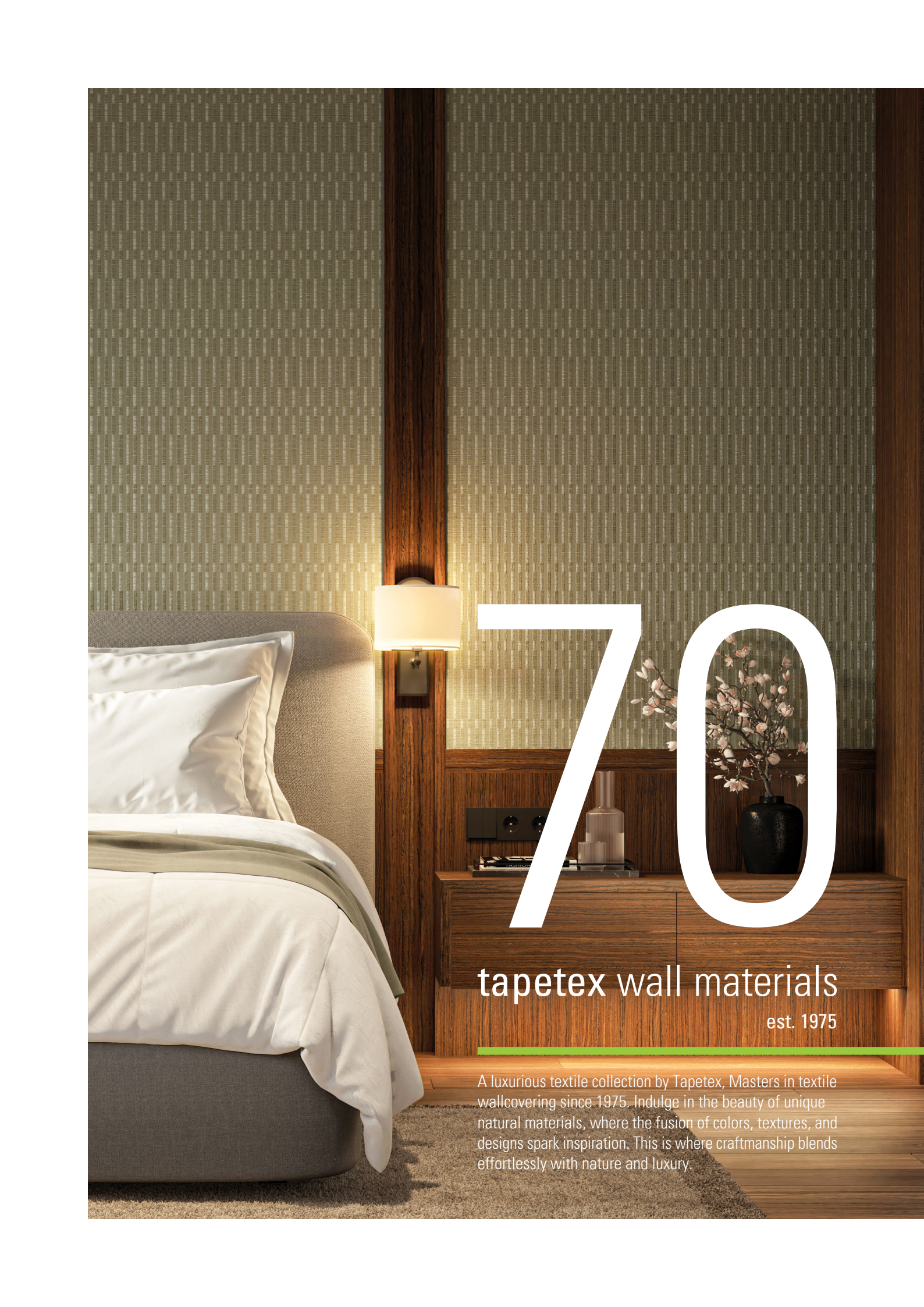

From nature to your wall

In this collection we use different sustainable fibers and transform them into exquisite wallcoverings. Our commitment to sustainability and innovation has led us to add two new fibers to our offering, hemp and nettle (rami); two exceptionally durable and eco-friendly materials.

Both are bast fibers, just like flax, where linen is made from. Bast fibers all have in common that they are soft, woody fibers obtained from the stem of plants. They are considered sustainable, regenerative fibers that are sourced from annually renewable plants.

Some advantages of bast fibers are that they prevent soil erosion and protect the soil's organic content, they require no fertilizer, irrigation and pesticides to grow and during the retting process they return nutrients to the soil and increase soil organic carbon content.



They support bees, producing large amounts of pollen late in the season.

Bast plants are some of the world's most efficient CO₂-to-biomass converters and due to whole-plant utilization waste is reduced to a minimum, maximizing and diversifying economic returns. Mother Nature knows Bast!

Cotton is made from the natural fiber of cotton plants and is primarily composed of cellulose (the main substance in the walls of plant cells, helping plants to remain stiff and upright). It is a soft and fluffy staple fiber that grows in a white boll around the seeds of the plant.

Cotton is produced in over 70 countries around the world and does not depend on fertilizer or additional irrigation to grow, as long as it is produced in an area which offers lots of sun, a long period without frost and a good amount of rain.

The natural cotton fiber is spun into yarn to create soft, durable fabrics that breath.



Another cellulose fiber that is frequently used in this collection is viscose. Viscose is a plant-based fiber, derived from the cellulose of fast growing and regenerating trees like eucalyptus, beech and pine or bamboo. Another name for viscose is rayon.

Silk is one of the most luxurious and sought-after fabrics in the world. It has been prized for centuries for its softness, sheen and durability. Silk is a natural, biodegradable fiber that comes from silkworms, primarily fed on mulberry leaves, which require minimal pesticides and water compared to other crops. The process of transforming the silk worm's cocoon into silk fabric is a fascinating but intricate one that requires precision and care.

Wool is the second animal-based fiber in this collection. Sheep are the principal source of wool, where the fiber is obtained from its fur. Wool is just like the other fibers described fully sustainable as it's 100% natural, renewable and biodegradable.

Wool grows naturally on sheep. Just by consuming a simple blend of water, air, sunshine and grass, sheep produce a new fleece every year. Other perks of wool are that it's an extremely durable fiber and it is naturally flame-retardant, due to its high water and nitrogen content.
